

GARDEN DESIGN


The decision has been made - you want to landscape your garden to improve your lifestyle and the value of the house. But what now, where do you go?

THE PROCESS

There are generally 3 stages in the design process:

Schematic design/ Concept Design Stage Can include:

Confirmation of project brief.

On site meeting with client and associated people. Produced hand drawn schematic plans and sections to establish area relationships and overall configuration of site.

Preliminary Design Stage

Can Include:

Developing the approved concept design into a more resolved design solution.

Produced computer generated Preliminary Plans.

Detailed Design Stage

Can Include:

Add construction details to approved Preliminary Plan.

Add Specifications to approved Preliminary Plan. Develop Preliminary Plans into form required for Permits etc.

It must be stressed that every project is different and that the included items vary with each project.


OUR DESIGN PHILOSOPHY
